Promotional Requirements

* *Promotion from Grade 9 to Grade 10* - The student has earned a minimum of eight credits.

* *Promotion from Grade 10 to Grade 11* - The student has earned a minimum of twenty credits, including four credits in Global History and four credits in English.

* *Promotion from Grade 11 to Grade 12* - The student has earned a minimum of thirty credits, including four credits in Global History and six credits in English.

Types of Diplomas:

Regents Diploma: All 5 Regents Exams must be passed with a 65 or higher.

College Ready: ELA exam score above 75, Algebra exam score above 80.

Advanced Regents Diploma: All 5 Regents exams must be passed with a 65 or higher, and student must pass the following additional Regents exams with a 65 or higher:

Geometry, Advanced Algebra/Trigonometry, Language Other Than English (LOTE) and a 2nd Science exam.

Advanced Regents Diploma with Honors: The average of all the scores on Regents exams required for the Advanced Regents diploma must be equal to or greater than 90.
